- 5. Used "surveytogo" application





Most serious problem facing Kenya




Respondents were asked: In your opinion, what is the most serious problem facing Kenya today?

Most serious problem facing household




Respondents were asked: How about your household, what would you say is the most serious problem facing your household today?









Satisfaction with the work of NGOs/CSOs
















Respondents were asked: Do you approve or disapprove of the handshake between President Uhuru Kenyatta and Raila Odinga?

Approve of the handshake | Gender & Rural/Urban













How much of a democracy is Kenya





Satisfaction with democracy














